Coverage

Products Warranted

This Warranty applies to the new Cummins Extarder by Jacobs and all parts necessary to install the Extarder (hereinafter the 'Product') with Cummins B or C series Engines. The Coverage is in effect where Cummins approved service is available.

This Warranty covers any failures of the Product, under normal use and service, which result from a defect in material or factory workmanship (Warrantable Failure). Coverage begins with the sale of the Product and continues for three years (unlimited mileage) from the date of delivery to the first retail purchaser or the date of first installation, whichever occurs first, on the Extarder, and for one year (unlimited mileage) from the date of delivery to the first retail purchaser or the date of first installation, whichever occurs first, on all components necessary for installation of the Product, including, but not limited to: auxiliary air supply; solenoid valve(s); wiring harness(es); switch(s); gasket(s); and pneumatic components.

This Warranty is made to all Owners in the chain of distribution and Coverage continues to all subsequent Owners until the end of the period of Coverage.

Cummins Responsibilities

Cummins will pay for all parts and labor needed to repair damage to the Product or Cummins Engine due to a Warrantable Failure.

Owner Responsibilities

Before the expiration of this Warranty, Owner must notify a Cummins distributor, authorized dealer, or other repair location approved by Cummins of any Warrantable Failure and make the Product available for repair by such facility. Locations in the United States and Canada are listed in the Cummins U.S. and Canada Sales and Service Directory; other locations

are listed in the Cummins International Sales and Service Directory.

In the event of any Product failure, Owner is responsible for the cost of delivering the Product to the repair location and for all associated delivery charges.

Limitations

Cummins is not responsible for failures or damage resulting from what Cummins determines to be abuse, neglect, unauthorized modification, or incorrect installation.

Cummins Inc. reserves the right to interrogate Electronic Control Module (ECM) data for purposes of failure analysis.

CUMMINS DOES NOT COVER WEAR OR WEAROUT OF COVERED PARTS.

CUMMINS IS NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR INCIDENTAL OR CONSEQUENTIAL DAMAGES.

THE WARRANTY SET FORTH HEREIN IS THE SOLE WARRANTY MADE BY CUMMINS IN REGARD TO THE PRODUCT. CUMMINS MAKES NO OTHER WARRANTIES, EXPRESS OR IMPLIED, OR OF MERCHANTABILITY OR FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE.

This warranty gives you specific legal rights, and you may also have other rights which vary from state to state.

In case of consumer sales, in some countries the Owner has statutory rights which cannot be affected or limited by the terms of this warranty.

Nothing in this warranty excludes or restricts any contractual rights the Owner may have against third parties.
